#### **Overall focus:**

- Address the challenges that tourism faces in territories (as opposed to tourism centers)
- High-level plenary session that raises four main topics in a transversal way (45 minutes)
- Two thematic sessions in plenary (2 x 45 minutes)
- Conclusions (plenary)

#### Rationale

The event on "Tourism and Territory: the New Challenges" addresses the regional dimension of tourism development in mostly rural areas, delving into four main challenges that relate with the regional dynamics that shape its evolution and impact.

Rural tourism, as a multifaceted domain, intertwines with various disciplines such as geography, economics, sociology, heritage and sustainable development. They are addressed in four policy contexts: regional development, Rural Pact, Digital and Green management of heritage and landscape, and inclusivity. This allows to for example examine data-driven approaches to understand visitor behaviour, quantify the economic impact, and strategize for the optimal utilization of regional resources, etc. Furthermore, we will look at policy frameworks that govern regional tourism, exploring how they can be tailored to ensure the equitable distribution of benefits across diverse communities.

The interplay of cultural heritage preservation, environmental conservation, and community engagement will be examined through case studies and practical examples.

Our discussions will revolve around these areas with an initial plenary session that sets the frame. This is followed by two blocks of two parallel breakout seminars that dive deeper into each of them. A final plenary session then presents the conclusions of the seminars and provides a generic closure.
