Contenuti e obiettivi formativi	<p>Content The Lab presents in full details the deep <i>interconnections between natural and cultural heritage</i>, and shows how their joint management is a prerequisite for a sustainable and integrated form of tourism development.</p> <p>Context The area chosen for the Lab is the Northern Adriatic Sea, and the system of Croatian islands and in-land areas strongly connected to the Venetian historical heritage. The area lies today at the crossroad between mass tourism, contested memories and marine natural parks.</p> <p>The involvement of local communities in planning local tourism frameworks is carefully analyzed, as it contributes to protect situated forms of knowledge, and to strengthen territorial preservation through the recovery of communities awareness.</p> <p>Aim The Lab intends to show how the confluence of <i>natural + cultural heritage sensitivities</i> helps to decipher the complex and layered heritage that characterizes the visited areas.</p>

<p>Articolazione del laboratorio</p>	<p>1) The conceptual frameworks and theoretical background necessary to understand the area and its criticalities are provided during 2-3 seminars, held by the teaching staff, in November 2023-January 2024.</p> <p>2) The practical experience consists in an intensive week of activities and navigation on board a traditional boat*, between May and June 2024. The boat is entirely dedicated to the international Summer School <i>Waterscape in Heritage and Environment</i>, where the LAB activities will be developed jointly with students from EU partner Universities.</p> <p>3) A follow up phase will conclude the lab in July, where reports and multi media productions will be produced and presented, according to specific assignments related to the practical experience.</p> <p><i>* NOTE: The costs of the accommodation on board will be partially covered by Unibg. A participation fee is still required. The costs of the travel to/from Croatia are supported by each participants.</i></p>
