Contenuti e obiettivi formativi	Aim of this Lab is to question the implications of the presence of tourism in Città Alta in Bergamo from the specific point of view of the families and children living in Città Alta. Families and children are typically using, exploiting and appropriating the green and open spaces of their neighborhood, making such public spaces a living and shared extension of their homes. The increasing presence of tourism in Città Alta creates the premises for the sharing of such green and open spaces with occasional and temporary users. The participants to the lab will investigate the relation between local families and children with “their” green and open spaces of Città Alta, as it changes and transforms due to the presence of increasing contemporary tourism. They will also analyze the resilience strategies enacted by the local community with respect of the new population of Città Alta, considering that the involvement of local communities in the planning and managing of public spaces contributes to protect the situated forms of knowledge, and to strengthen territorial preservation.
Articolazione del laboratorio	1) The conceptual frameworks and the methodological background needed to read the context and to develop the short fieldwork will be provided during one/two seminars, held by Prof. Bougleux and Prof. Daniele at the beginning of the lab.



	2) The practical experience will consist in: - a short fieldwork, aimed at interviewing tourists and families living in Città Alta on the topics introduced by the seminars, i.e the perception, availability and use of green and open spaces of Città Alta; - a documental and data research on the residential population / families / children living in Città Alta <i>versus</i> the tourism population increasing in the last few years. 3) The final production will consist in a written/media/visual report of the achievements of the Lab, with emphasis on the relevance of the residential <i>versus</i> tourist perception of green and open spaces in Città Alta.
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
