Contenuti e obiettivi formativi	Aim of this Lab is to present in full details how to frame a sustainable and integrated form of marine tourism development, enacted by Our vision on integrated tourism development intends to address <i>cultural</i> and <i>natural</i> heritage as entangled concepts, that cannot be separated. The emerging global sensitivity for a green approach to tourism requires in fact the superposition of locality and sustainability as independent concepts. The involvement of local communities in planning and mastering territorial and marine resources contributes to protect situated forms of knowledge, and to strengthen environment preservation through communities' awareness. The Lab intends to show how the confluence of natural + cultural heritage sensitivities, as well as the convergence of local knowledge + global frameworks, is not only possible, but also close to our direct experience.
Articolazione del laboratorio	 The conceptual frameworks and theoretical background necessary to understand the excursion proposal will be provided during three seminars, to be held by Prof. Bougleux and the selected expert, in the second semester of a.y. 2025/26 The practical experience will consist in a Summer School taking place in the Summer 2026. The Students will be hosted on a traditional wooden gullet for one week, together with professor and local experts who will present and introduce to the local environment and heritage, according to a daily
