Contenuti e obiettivi formativi	<p>Aim of this Lab is to present in full details the capability of framing a sustainable and integrated form of tourism development, enacted by a local reality in the proximity of Bergamo.</p> <p>Talking about integrated tourism development we intend to address cultural and natural heritage as entangled concepts which cannot be separated. The emerging sensitivity for a green approach to tourism requires in fact the superposition of such concepts. At the same time the involvement of local communities and global frameworks contribute together, thanks to local and situated forms of knowledge, to the strengthening of territorial preservation and communities awareness.</p> <p>The Lab intends to show how such confluence of natural + cultural heritage sensitivity, as well as the convergence of local knowledge + global frameworks, is not only possible, but also close to our direct experience.</p>
Articolazione del laboratorio	<p>1) The conceptual frameworks and theoretical background necessary to understand the excursion proposal will be provided during three seminars, to be held by Prof. Bougleux and possible local stakeholders, between end of October and mid November 2021.</p> <p>2) The practical experience will consist in a two phases experiential work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- a residential workshop in Valle Brembana, provisionally set up for November 22-24, where the students will meet the actors of the local community network which give life to the sustainable and

	<p>integrated tourism development. Meetings with local stakeholders, working seminars and excursions will touch the following crucial topics: <u>local biodiversity, local cultural and museums heritage, km0 food and goods production, local archives consultation, history of territorial resources as local memory archives.</u></p> <p>- an independent group-work, where students will develop and deepen one (or more) particular aspect among those presented during the residential workshop, possibly going back to the excursion sites and/or consulting local materials, archives, people.</p> <p>3) The report production will consist in a written/media/visual presentation of the achievements of the Lab, with emphasis on the relevance of the residential experience offered in order to acquire a direct approach to the topics developed.</p>
